What do I need to register as a voter?

Identity card/valid passport

2.

What happens when I register as a voter?

- Present yourself to the nearest registration office with your ID/ Valid Passport.
- Fill out an Application for Registration Form (Form A)
- You will be issued with an Acknowledgment Slip bearing your details.

(However, this slip is not a requirement for voting)

Can you be denied registration?

Yes

When?

- If you are below 18 years of age
- If you do not possess a Kenyan ID/Valid passport
- If you are an undischarged bankrupt
- If you have been found guilty by an election court or reported to be guilty of any election offence during the preceding five years.

Can I register more than once?

No. You can only register once and it's an offence to register more than once.
